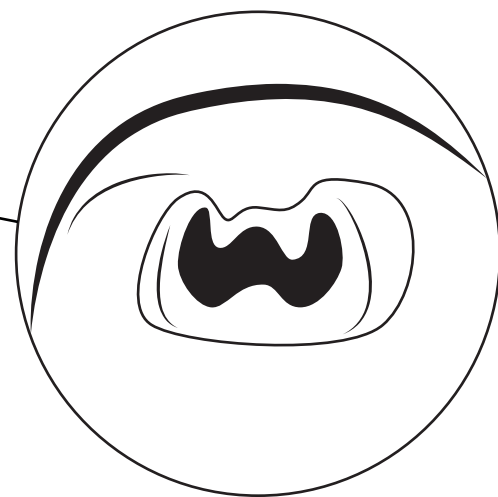

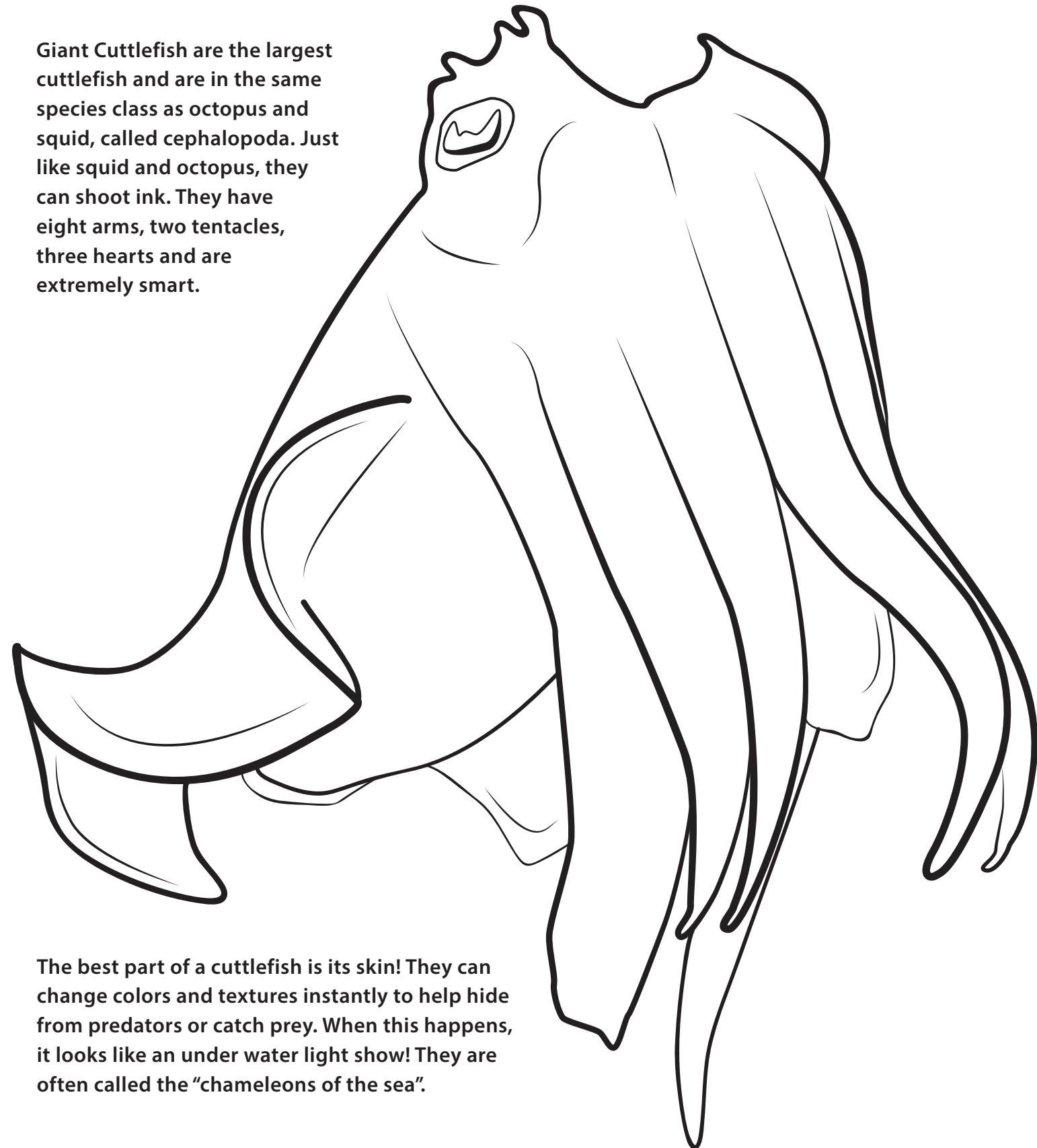
THE GIANT

What makes a CUTTLEFISH SPECIAL

Giant Cuttlefish are the largest cuttlefish and are in the same species class as octopus and squid, called cephalopoda. Just like squid and octopus, they can shoot ink. They have eight arms, two tentacles, three hearts and are extremely smart.



The best part of a cuttlefish is its skin! They can change colors and textures instantly to help hide from predators or catch prey. When this happens, it looks like an under water light show! They are often called the "chameleons of the sea".
